## Chiropractors and Osteopaths (Fees) Determination 2003 (No 1)

**Disallowable instrument DI2003-241** 

made under the

Chiropractors and Osteopaths Act 1983, s 54 (Determination of fees)

The Chiropractors and Osteopaths Act 1983 (the Act) provides for the control of the practice of chiropractic and osteopathy and for related purposes.

This instrument revokes all previous determinations of fees and sets new fees for initial registration pursuant to Sections 7 and 9; fee for annual renewal registration pursuant to Section 26(1); entitlement to re-registration pursuant to Section 28(1); fee for interim registration pursuant to Section 10(2), fee for alteration of particulars in the register pursuant to Section 31(2); fee for duplicate certificate pursuant to Section 29(4); fee to inspect an entry in the register pursuant to Section 48(1) and fee to obtain a certified copy of an entry in the register pursuant to Section 48(1).

The fees for initial registration, annual renewals and other miscellaneous fees have been set at levels which reflect the administrative costs associated with those activities, and to meet the agreed costs of operating the Health Professions Boards Secretariat.
