INSTRUMENT NO. 215 OF 2000

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Education Services for Overseas Students (Registration and Regulation of Providers) Act 1994, sub-sections 1 and 2 commenced operation on 23 November 1994 and the remainder on 23 May 1995. The Act provides for registration and regulation of education providers for overseas students and the maintenance of a register known as the Register of Institutions Providing Education and Training for Overseas Students (Category 2).

Section 41 of the Act provides for fees to be determined for the purposes of the Act.

Section 7(1) states that an institution or other body or person may apply to the Chief Executive for approval as a provider of a specified course or courses to overseas students. Section 7 (2) (c) (iii) states that an application be accompanied by the determined fee.

The fees for 2000-01 have increased from the existing 1999-00 fees by the Consumer Price Index of 2.5% as advised by the Department of Treasury and Infrastructure.
