REVOCATION AND DETERMINATION OF FEES

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

INSTRUMENT No. 163 OF 2000

This Determination made under section 52A of the Surveyors Act 1967 (the Act) revokes the existing Determination of Fees and sets the fees for the purposes of the Act.

The combined fee for annual registration with both the ACT and the NSW jurstriction is set at 75% of the combined individual fees for 2000-01. As NSW is yet to determine a fee for 2000-01 the combined fee at this stage is unknown but will be calculated in line with the current agreement. The Act will retain only its proportion of the fee, being 75% of \$282.00. The balance eof the fee will be kept by NSW. In effect both the ACT and NSW will receive 75% of the normal registration from those surveyors who register in both jursidictions.

The remaining fees have increased as a result of CPI adjustments in accordance with Government policy.
