DETERMINATION OF FEES

INSTRUMENT NO. 173 OF 1999

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Gaming Machine Act 1987 (the Act) provides for the taxing of gross revenue from gaming machines and the necessary administrative support and inspection powers for the regulation and control of gaming machine operations in the ACT.

Division 4 of Part V of the Act, deals with the control of gaming machines and linked jackpot arrangements. In particular, subsection 45G(1) requires a written request for a variation of an interclub permit. Subsection 45G(1) of the Act was recently amended so that a fee must accompany each application.

This determination under section 66 of the Act, for the purposes of subsection 45G(1), sets the fee that shall accompany a written request for a variation of an inter-club linked jackpot permit at \$500 and applies on and from 1 July 1999.
