EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Instrument No. 164 of 1998

This Determination made under section 80 of the Energy and Water Act 1988 (the Act) revokes the existing Determination of Fees and sets the fees for the purposes of the Act.

As a result of changes in Government policy, the fees made under the Building Act 1972 include a hydraulic component. The corresponding fees under the Energy and Water Act 1988 apply to work that does not require approval under the Building Act 1972.

All fees have increased as a result of CPI adjustments in accordance with Government policy.
