REVOCATION AND DETERMINATION OF FEES
Instrument No. 139 of 1998
EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Animal Diseases Act 1993 ('the Act') provides for the control of endemic and exotic diseases of animals and for related purposes

Under Section 63 of the Animal Diseases Act 1993 the Minister may, by notice published in the Gazette, determine fees for the purposes of the Act. This Instrument sets out a fee for the provision of emergency tail tags in case the original tags are missing at the point of sale or slaughter. The tags are used for disease tracing. The fee is set out below, the amount in brackets is the previous charge.

The fee payable under the Animal Diseases Act 1993 has been reviewed and increased generally in line with the Consumer Price Index.
