DETERMINATION OF FEES

**NO. 67 OF 1995**

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Registration of Births, Deaths And Marriages Act 1963 prescribes the procedures for the reporting of a birth, death or marriage in the Territory and requires the Registrar to maintain Registers of Births, Deaths, Marriages and Parentage Information. In particular, section 62 enables the Minister to determine fees for the purposes of the Act.

This Determination revokes Determination of Fees No 72 of 1994 made on 22 June 1994 and notified in the Australian Capital Territory Gazette No. S127 of 27 June 1994 and determines that the various fees payable under the Act, including fees for registration of a name, searching of a Register, requesting copies of documents held in the Registers and the posting of notices, shall be as set out in the Schedule to the Determination.

A statement of the old and new fees is attached.

The fees have generally been increased by 4% in accordance with the anticipated movement in 1995/96 of the Consumer Price Index. Fees are set with a view to full cost recovery and having regard to charges levied for similar interstate services.
