**DETERMINATION OF QUANTITY OF TOBACCO**

**NO. 126 OF 1995**

**EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

Section 24 (1A) of the Business Franchise (Tobacco and Petroleum Products) Act 1984 provides for the determination of a quantity of tobacco, in excess of which a person, other than the holder of a wholesale tobacco licence, who has possession or control of such a quantity shall be presumed to be carrying on tobacco wholesaling. However this presumption is rebuttable.

This instrument sets the quantity for the purposes of section 24 (1A) to be

- (a) in the case of tobacco in the form of cigarettes - 3,500 cigarettes, or
- (b) in the case of tobacco in any other form - 5 kilograms

This determination is to take effect from the date of gazettal.
