DETERMINATION OF FEES

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Smoke-free Areas (Enclosed Public Places) Act 1994 prohibits or restricts tobacco smoking in certain enclosed public places.

Section 19A of the Act enables the Minister to determine fees for the purposes of the Act.

This is a new determination which incorporates fees for the purpose of lodging an application for exemption certificate by the occupier of a restaurant. It also incorporates annual fees payable on or before the first and second anniversaries of the grant of the certificate of exemption. Part of the fee payable on application will be returned to an applicant if the application is unsuccessful.
