EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Registration of Deeds Act 1957 governs the registration of miscellaneous deeds in the Australian Capital Territory. In particular section 8 enables the Minister to determine fees for the purposes of the Act.

This Determination revokes Determination of Fees No 68 of 1993 made on 22 June 1993 and notified in the Australian Capital Territory Gazette No S119 of 30 June 1993 and determines that the fees payable under the Act shall be as set out in the Schedule to the Determination.

A statement of the old and new fees is attached

The fees have generally been increased by 3% in accordance with the anticipated movement in 1994/95 of the Consumer Price Index. Fees have been compared with those charged by other States and the Northern Territory to ensure equity of treatment. Revenue collected from the fees will place the Registrar-General's Office at full cost recovery.
