EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Section 132 of the Casino Control Act 1988 allows the Minister to determine fees that relate to the purposes of the Act.

The Act states that the application for a casino employee's licence, as well as a variation, renewal and replacement of a licence are subject to the applicant paying the Casino Surveillance Authority a determined fee.

I have determined that the fee structure regarding casino employee's licences shall be:

•	Key Employee's Licence Application (section 89)	\$258.00
•	Operation's Employee's Licence Application (section 89)	\$155.00
•	Renewal of a Employee's Licence (section 97)	\$31.00
•	Variation of Employee's Licence (section 98)	\$31.00
•	Replacement copy of a Employee's Licence (section 99)	\$31.00

All fees are based on the cost of recovery for the Casino Surveillance Authority's administration time and the fees charged by the Australian Federal Police for security checks. The proposed fees are consistent with fees charged in other States.
