The Podiatrists Act 1994 (the Act) provides for the control of the practice of podiatry and for related purposes.

This instrument revokes all previous determinations of fees and sets new fees for initial registration in accordance with Section 17(2); fee for annual renewal registration pursuant to 27(1); entitlement to reregistration in accordance with Section 29(1); fee for interim registration pursuant to Section 11(2); fee for alteration of particulars in the register pursuant to Section 26(2); fee for duplicate certificate pursuant to section 24(4); fee to inspect an entry in the register pursuant to section 50(1) and fee to obtain a certified copy of an entry in the register pursuant to Section 50(1).

The fees for initial registration, annual renewals and other miscellaneous fees have been set at levels which reflect the administrative costs associated with those activities, and to meet the agreed costs of operating the Health Professions Boards Secretariat.
