The Australian Capital Territory Credit Tribunal (the Credit Tribunal) is established under the *Credit Act 1985* (the Act). The Credit Tribunal hears certain kinds of disputes between parties to a credit transaction. The Credit Tribunal also holds disciplinary inquiries into the conduct of credit providers.

The Credit Tribunal consists of a Chairperson and two members. Provision is also made for an acting Chairperson and two acting members who act on the Tribunal in the event of a vacancy or absence.
