If you believe the party should not be registered:

- . because it does not have as an objective the promotion of the election to the Assembly of candidates it has endorsed; or
- . because the application does not meet the technical requirements of the Act; or
- . because its name (or abbreviation) is likely to be confused with that of another registered party,

you can formally object by writing to the Australian Electoral Commission. Your submission, which must be signed and contain your address, should be lodged with the Australian Electoral Commission, PO Box E201, Queen Victoria Terrace ACT 2600 before 27 December 1989.
