INSTRUMENT OF APPROVAL UNDER SECTION 10

Under section 10 of the City Area Leases Act 1936 I CARL JAMES THOMPSON APPROVE of MICHAEL JOHN KNEEBONE ("the Applicant") carrying on the profession trade occupation or calling of MEDICAL PRACTITIONER ("the business") on Block 10 Section 4 Division of COOK known as 35 BIFFIN STREET COOK ("the land") subject to the following conditions relating to the use of the land being observed by the Applicant in carrying on the business -

- 1 that this approval will remain valid only while the Applicant continues to be a bona fide resident of the land;
- 2 that the Applicant will ensure that the conduct of the business does not cause an annoyance a nuisance or danger and is not offensive to any tenants or occupiers of adjoining lands;
- that the Applicant will not exhibit any notice, advertisement, sign or hoarding on the property. In accordance with your application, a sign up to 500mm x 300mm in size indicating the name and occupation of the resident, can only be exhibited on the dwelling house;
- that the Applicant will conduct the business strictly in accordance with the application made by the Applicant under section 10 of the City Area Leases Act 1936 unless otherwise stipulated in this Instrument;
- of the Minister employ any more than two assistants for the purpose of conducting or carrying on the business on the land and those assistants shall only be employed in the capacity of nurse or receptionist;
- that the business will only be conducted on the land between the hours of 9.00 am to 6.00 pm Monday to Friday;
- that no person other than the Applicant will conduct or in any way carry on the business on the land without the prior approval of the Minister;
- 8 that the Applicant will ensure that all residence and business related vehicles are parked within the confines of the land;

- 9 that the Applicant will abide by Clinical Waste Act 1990 by disposing of their Clinical Waste in the manner designated by the Clinical Waste Manual;
- 10 that the Applicant provide at least four carparking spaces on the land for parking of patient's vehicles;
- that this approval will terminate on the THIRTIETH day of JUNE 1994 or on such earlier date as the Minister determines in accordance with condition 12;
- upon any failure to comply with any or all of the foregoing conditions the Minister or his Delegate under the said Act may give written notice requiring the Applicant to show cause within a period of fourteen days why this approval should not be revoked. At the expiration of this period the Minister or his Delegate may revoke the approval.
