CITY AREA LEASES ACT 1936


INSTRUMENT OF APPROVAL UNDER SECTION 10

Under section 10 of the City Area Leases Act 1936 I CARL JAMES THOMPSON APPROVE of MARC DAVID PILKINTON ("the Applicant") carrying on the profession trade occupation or calling of VETERINARY SURGEON ("the business") on Block 22 Section 42 Division of MONASH known as 111 CLIVE STEELE AVENUE MONASH ("the land") subject to the following conditions relating to the use of the land being observed by the Applicant in carrying on the business -

- 1 that this approval will remain valid only while the Applicant continues to be a bona fide resident of the land;
- 2 that the Applicant will ensure that the conduct of the business does not cause an annoyance a nuisance or danger and is not offensive to any tenants or occupiers of adjoining lands;
- 3 that the Applicant will not exhibit any notice, advertisement, sign or hoarding on the property. In accordance with your application, a sign up to 500mm x 300mm in size indicating the name and occupation of the resident, can only be exhibited on the dwelling house;
- 4 that the Applicant will conduct the business strictly in accordance with the application made by the Applicant under section 10 of the City Area Leases Act 1936 unless otherwise stipulated in this Instrument;
- 5 that no person other than the Applicant will conduct or in any way carry on the business on the land without the prior approval of the Minister;
- 6 that the Applicant will ensure that all residence and business related vehicles are parked within the confines of the land and that all business related vehicles are parked behind the front building line and on the hardstanding carpark as shown on the plan included on the application;
- 7 that the Applicant will abide by Clinical Waste Act 1990 by disposing of their Clinical Waste in the manner designated by the Clinical Waste Manual;
- 8 that the Applicant will not employ more than one assistant for the purpose of conducting or carrying on the business on the land without the prior approval of the Minister;

- 9 that only the approved area be used for the conduct of the business;
- 10 that the business will only be conducted on the land between the hours of 8.30 am to 6.30 pm Monday to Friday, 9.00 am to 10.00 pm Saturdays, and other times for emergencies only;
- 11 that the applicant will instruct clients to use on-site parking by printing on appointment cards and verbally when taking appointments;
- 12 that the Applicant will conduct the business strictly by appointment, and that such appointments will be arranged to allow fifteen minutes between the finish of one appointment and the start of the next;
- 13 that the Applicant will ensure that all kennels are to be satisfactorily soundproofed;
- 14 that the Applicant will ensure that provision is made for the safe disposal of dead animal carcasses and body parts;
- 15 that the Applicant will ensure that disposal of wastes from yards and pens comply with the provisions of the Public Health (General Sanitation) Regulations;
- 16 that this approval will terminate on the THIRTY FIRST day of JULY 1994 or on such earlier date as the Minister determines in accordance with condition 17;
- 17 upon any failure to comply with any or all of the foregoing conditions the Minister or his Delegate under the said Act may give written notice requiring the Applicant to show cause within a period of fourteen days why this approval should not be revoked. At the expiration of this period the Minister or his Delegate may revoke the approval.
