DRAFT VARIATION NO.92 TO THE TERRITORY PLAN DUNLOP (WEST BELCONNEN) - DUNLOP HILLS RESERVE

The Planning and Land Management Group (PALM) of the Department of Urban Services (incorporating the ACT Planning Authority) is proposing a draft Vanation to the Territory Plan which, if adopted, would:

amend the Territory Plan Map to reserve areas of natural temperate grassland and grassy woodland at Dunlop, in the Hills Ridges and Buffer Areas Land Use Policy, as Public Land Nature Reserve; and

rationalise the boundary of the residential area to relate more closely to the reserve and to include a buffer zone along the urban development edge

This draft Variation is to have interim effect under the provision of section 9 of the Land (Planning and Environment) Act 1991 for the "defined period".
