DRAFT VARIATION NO 109 TO THE TERRITORY PLAN PROPOSED AREA SPECIFIC POLICIES B11 AND B12 IN NORTH CANBERRA AND APPENDIX III 3 URBAN HOUSING CODE

A draft Variation to the Territory Plan concerning the Proposed Area Specific Policies B11 and B12 in North Carberra and Appendix III 3 Urban Housing Code, has been prepared by the Planning and Land Management Group (PALM) of the Department of Urban Services (incorporating the functions of the ACT Planning Authority)

Draft Variation No 109 replaces draft Variation No 82, which has been withdrawn with effect from 15 May 1998

The draft Variation proposes dividing selected B1 areas in North Canberra excluding those immediately adjacent to Northbourne Avenue and Ainslie Avenue into two distinct Area Specific Policies identified as the B11 Urban Housing area and the B12 Urban Housing area This proposal is a commutation of the general concept originally proposed in draft Variation No S2. However a number of specific refinements have been incorporated to respond to issues raised during the original consultation on draft Variation No S2 and in subsequent meetings with resident group representatives.
