DRAFT ENVIRONMENTAL FLOW GUIDELINES

The ACT *Water Resources Act 1998* was passed in the Legislative Assembly on 26 November 1998. The Act provides for the sustainable management of surface and groundwater resources of the Territory. Section 5 of the Act requires that guidelines for ascertaining flows necessary to maintain aquatic ecosystems are developed.

Draft Environmental Flow Guidelines are now available for public comment until 16 February 1999.
