**Draft Variation No.217** to the Territory Plan, for the Heritage Places Register – Whitley Houses at Griffith Section 23 Blocks 6, 11 & 12 and Braddon Section 10 Block 4, has been prepared by the ACT Planning and Land Authority.

The draft Variation proposes to enter the Whitley Houses onto the Heritage Places Register Appendix V of the Territory Plan Written Statement. The index showing all the places entered on the Register to date will also be updated to include the new place, and it is also proposed to amend the Territory Plan Map by adding the Heritage Places Register 'H' Overlay to these sites.
