6 Temporary Standard Exemption Standard

YMCA Ngunnawal Playschool operated by Young Men's Christian Association of Canberra Inc is exempt from complying with *Children and Young People (ACT Childcare Services) Standards 2009 (No 1)* –

1.47) Positions requiring a qualified person must be filled by an adult who holds one of the following qualifications:

a) a Diploma in Community Services (Children's Services) or equivalent;

b) a Bachelor of Early Childhood Education;

c) an equivalent 3 year full time tertiary qualification specialising in early childhood from a university

d) a recognised overseas equivalent of any of the above qualifications.

7 Explanation and Additional Conditions

The service will be operating with a Primary trained teacher while continuing to recruit an Early Childhood qualified teacher.
