1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Utilities (Revocation of Licence) Notice 2011 (No 1)*.

2 Revocation of utility licence— Sanctuary Energy Pty Ltd

Under section 42 of the Utilities Act, the Independent Competition and Regulatory Commission (Commission) revokes the utility licence held by Sanctuary Energy Pty Ltd to supply electricity in the ACT. The decision to revoke Sanctuary Energy Pty Ltd utility licence is a consequence of Sanctuary Energy Pty Ltd's licence fees remaining unpaid for a period greater than 28 days after the due date for payment.

The revocation takes effect from 2 September 2011.
