1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the Housing Assistance Public Rental Housing Assistance Program (Special Needs Applicants and Dwellings) Determination 2012

(No 1).

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after notification.

3 Determination

In accordance with clause 19(6) of the Program I determine that, subject to the exercise of reasonable flexibility, the classes of special needs dwellings identified in Column 1 are to be allocated as rental housing assistance otherwise than in accordance with the general allocation provisions set out in the Program to the class of special needs applicants identified in Column 2 opposite and in relation to the relevant class of dwellings.
