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#### Successful completion of the course requires:

- 1. An 85% pass rate and the full two (2) days classroom attendance.
- 2. Completion of the E-training course for taxi drivers online.
- 3. Completion of a minimum 21 hours of jockeying.
- 4. A satisfactory practical WAT assessment.
- 5. Being awarded a certificate of competency upon successful completion of the Theory Test and Practical Assessment as a means of obtaining a TAXI ('T') code added to any licence class other than a motor cycle class.

6. The competencies that must be achieved from the Transport and Logistics Training Package TLI10 are:

TLIC2009A – Drive taxicab

TLIB2090A – Use communication systems in a taxicab

TLIF2072A – Comply with safety and security procedures

TLIH3004A – Identify major roads, services and attractions

TLII2019A - Provide taxicab customer service

TLIL2060A – Complete induction to the transport industry

TLIP2037A – Carry out financial transactions and maintain records

7. A driver of a Wheelchair Accessible Taxi must also achieve the competency: TLIC2040A – Provide wheelchair accessible taxi services to passengers with disabilities.

Practical assessment must occur using a wheelchair accessible taxi or a standalone taxi (ie simulator) in a workplace suitable for this purpose.
