1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Electricity Feed-in (Large-scale Renewable Energy Generation) FiT Entitlement 2016 (No 2).*

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after notification.

3 Grant of FiT Entitlement

I grant

SWF1 Operations Pty Ltd (ACN 601 425 316) (FiT entitlement holder)

a FiT entitlement as set out in sections 4 to 8 of this instrument.

4 Term

The term of the FiT entitlement is 20 years commencing on 1 May 2018.

5 Amount of feed-in tariff entitlement

The amount of the FiT entitlement is \$89.10 (GST exclusive) per megawatt-hour.

6 Maximum quantity of eligible electricity

The maximum quantity of eligible electricity, in a financial year, in relation to which the FiT entitlement holder is entitled to be paid a FiT support payment, is 397,704 megawatt hours.

7 Requirements for the FiT entitlement holder's large renewable energy generator

The FiT entitlement holder's large renewable energy generator must:

- 1. Be located around 28km east of Inverell and 18km west of Glen Innes in the state of New South Wales in accordance with planning approvals relating to Development Application number MP 09_0093 granted on 26 June 2013 under the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act* 1979 (NSW);
- 2. Use wind energy as its renewable energy source;
- 3. Have a generating capacity no greater than 100.0 megawatts alternating current at the point of electrical connection to the national electricity system; and
- 4. Consist of up to 32 wind turbine generators, connected via a transformer to a single point of connection to the national electricity system.

8 Transfer of large-scale generation certificates

Large-scale generation certificates (or any similar benefit available to generators under future Commonwealth laws that amend or replace the law providing for large-scale generation certificates) for eligible electricity generated by the FiT entitlement holder's large renewable energy generator during the term of the FiT entitlement must be created and transferred to the Territory under the *Renewable Energy (Electricity) Act 2000* (Cwlth) or future Commonwealth laws that might amend or replace that Act.
