In this instrument:


parts of Cygnet Crescent road reserve means the part of Cygnet Crescent road reserve between Sections 25, 26, 31 and 40 in the Division of Red Hill, as identified in schedule 1 by grey shading as an area of intended road closure; and the part of Cygnet Crescent road reserve adjacent Section 32 in the Division of Red Hill, as identified in the schedule 2 by grey shading as an area of intended road closure.

*Lady Nelson Place road reserve* means the whole of the Lady Nelson Place road reserve, which is adjacent Sections 25, 26 and 40 in the Division of Red Hill, as identified in the schedule 1 by grey shading as an area of intended road closure.




**DIVISION OF RED HILL**
