1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Children and Young People (Childcare Service Licence) Temporary Standards Exemption 2017 (No 4)*.

2 Purpose of this Instrument

This instrument is to issue a *Temporary Standards Exemption* as specified in Section 749 (2) of the *Children and Young People Act 2008*.

3 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after notification.

4 Expiry

This instrument expires six (6) months after the day it commences.

6 Temporary Standard Exemption Standard

Kidstart Southside operated by Kristen O'Connor is exempt from complying with *Children and Young People (ACT Childcare Services) Standards 2009 (No 1) – Standard 1.47*

Standard 1.47 Staff Qualifications:

Position requiring a qualified person must be filled by an adult who holds one of the following qualifications:

- a) a Diploma in Community Services (Children's Services) or equivalent;*
- b) a Bachelor of Early Childhood Education;*
- c) an equivalent 3 year full time tertiary qualification specialising in early childhood from a university;*
- d) a recognised overseas equivalent of any of the above qualifications; or an adult who:*
- e) has completed the certificate three component of a Diploma qualification as described above, or*
- f) has completed half a Degree qualification as described above and*
- g) demonstrates continuing progress toward completion of the qualification and is approved to work in the position by the licensing authority.*

7 Explanation and Additional Conditions

The service is allowed to operate using educators on the Wednesday morning and Friday morning and afternoon sessions, who do not hold an early childhood qualification.

In addition, the service is allowed to operate using regular relief educators for short term replacement of qualified educators, who do not hold an early childhood qualification.

This Temporary Standard Exemption (TSE) applies to the educators specified in the application for this TSE.

This TSE expires six months from notification.
