

TRESPASS ON COMMONWEALTH LANDS.

No. 9 of 1923.^(a)

An Ordinance to amend the Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance 1922-1923.^(b)

BE it ordained by the Deputy of the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act* 1909 and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act* 1910, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance* 1923 (No. 2).

(2.) Sub-section (2.) of section one of the *Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance* 1923 is repealed.

(3.) The *Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance* 1922, as amended by the *Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance* 1923 and by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance* 1922-1923.

Laying poison.

2. Section two of the *Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance* 1922 is amended by inserting, after sub-section (2.) thereof, the following sub-section:—

“(3.) Any person who, without authority in writing from the officer administering this Ordinance, lays poison on any land belonging to, or in the occupation of, the Commonwealth, shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: Twenty pounds.”
