# FEDERAL CAPITAL COMMISSION'S POWERS.

# No. 12 of 1924.(a)

An Ordinance to transfer to the Federal Capital Commission the Powers and Functions of the Minister under Ordinances of the Territory, and for other purposes.

DE it ordained by the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909 and the Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Federal Capital Commission's Powers Ordinance 1924.

Commencement.

2. This Ordinance shall commence on the first day of January, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-five.

Definition.

- 3. In this Ordinance—
  - "Federal Capital Commission" means the Federal Capital Commission established under the Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1924.

Repeal

- 4.—(1.) The Ordinances mentioned in the First Schedule to this Ordinance are, to the extent therein expressed, hereby repealed.
- (2.) The repeal of any provision of an Ordinance effected by the last preceding sub-section shall not affect the operation of any regulation or notice made or published under that Ordinance which is in force at the commencement of this Ordinance, and any such regulation or notice shall continue in force subject to any by-law made by the Federal Capital Commission under the Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1924.

Powers and functions Federal Capital Commission. 5. After the commencement of this Ordinance all the powers and functions exercisable by, and anything required to be done by, to or before the Minister or the Administrator under any Ordinance mentioned in the Second Schedule to this Ordinance or under any regulation made under any such Ordinance shall be exercisable by, and done by, to or before the Federal Capital Commission and shall cease to be exercisable by, and shall not be done by, to or before the Minister or Administrator, and any reference in any such Ordinance or regulation to the Minister or the Administrator shall be read as a reference to the Federal Capital Commission.
