THE TERRITORY FOR THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT.

No. 32 of 1933.

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Interpretation Ordinance 1914-1930.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1933*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Interpretation Ordinance 1933*. Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Interpretation Ordinance 1914-1930* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Interpretation Ordinance 1914-1933*.

2. Section two of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the figures and words “1901-1918 and of sections one to eight inclusive of the *Acts Interpretation Act 1904-1916*” and inserting in their stead the figures and words “1901-1932 (except section fifteen A) and of sections one to eight inclusive and nine A of the *Acts Interpretation Act 1904-1932*”. Application of Acts Interpretation Acts to Ordinances.
