No. 32 of 1933.

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Interpretation Ordinance 1914-1930.

B E it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909 and the Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1933, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Interpretation short title and Ordinance 1933.

(2.) The Interpretation Ordinance 1914-1930 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Interpretation Ordinance* 1914-1933.

2. Section two of the Principal Ordinance is amended by application omitting the figures and words "1901-1918 and of sections one to interpretation eight inclusive of the Acts Interpretation Act 1904-1916" and Acts to ordinances. inserting in their stead the figures and words "1901-1932 (except section fifteen A) and of sections one to eight inclusive and nine A of the Acts Interpretation Act 1904-1932".
