

# THE TERRITORY FOR THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT.

No. 38 of 1933.

## AN ORDINANCE

**To provide for the Modification of the Provisions of  
certain Ordinances in relation to the exercise of  
the Jurisdiction of the Supreme Court.**

**B**E it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act* 1909 and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act* 1910-1933, as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Supreme Court (Ordinances* Short title.  
*Modifying) Ordinance* 1933.
2. This Ordinance shall come into operation on the first day of Commencement.  
January, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-four.
3. In this Ordinance, unless the contrary intention appears— Definition.  
“Supreme Court” means the Supreme Court of the Australian  
Capital Territory.
4. In the Ordinances specified in the Schedule to this Ordinance— Modification of  
provision of  
certain  
Ordinances.
  - (a) any reference to the High Court of Australia or the High Court or to the Justices thereof shall be read as a reference to the Supreme Court ;
  - (b) any reference to a Justice or a single Justice of the High Court shall be read as a reference to the Judge of the Supreme Court ;
  - (c) any reference to the Principal Registrar or to the Registrar of the High Court or to a District Registrar of the High Court shall be read as a reference to the Registrar of the Supreme Court ;
  - (d) any reference to Rules of the High Court or to rules made by the Justices of the High Court or to Rules made under the *High Court Procedure Act* 1903-1925 and the *Judiciary Act* 1903-1927, shall be read as a reference to rules governing the procedure and practice of the Supreme Court :

Provided that nothing in this section shall apply in relation to the *Matrimonial Causes Ordinance* 1932, the *Juries Ordinance* 1932-1933, section one hundred and seventy-three of the *Real Property Ordinance* 1925-1933, or section two of the *Judgment Creditors Remedies Ordinance* 1933.
