TERRITORY FOR THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT.

No. 6 of 1935. AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Lotteries and Art Unions Ordinance 1926-1933.

IE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909 and the Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1933, as follows:-

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Lotteries and Art Short title and Unions Ordinance 1935.

- (2.) The Lotteries and Art Unions Ordinance 1926-1933 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Lotteries and Art Unions Ordinance 1926-1935.
- 2. After section twenty-four of the Principal Ordinance, the following section is inserted:-

"24a. Any person who-

(a) for hire, gain or reward, promotes or takes part in the formation of syndicates for formation of a syndicate for the purchase of purchase of shares in a ticket in any lottery whatsoever, whether conducted lotteries or to be conducted within or outside the Territory, including any lottery authorized by or under, and conducted or to be conducted in accordance with, the law of any State or Territory or otherwise; or

(b) by any means advertises or prints or publishes any advertisement that he or any other person is prepared to receive money for a share in a ticket to be purchased in any such lottery,

shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: One hundred pounds.".
