AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Liquor Ordinance 1942 and for other purposes.

R E it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938 and the Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1940, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Liquor Ordinance 1945. short title

2. Section three of the Liquor Ordinance 1942 is repealed.

3. The Liquor Ordinance 1943 is repealed.
