AN ORDINANCE

To make provision for the Continuance of the Police Arbitral Tribunal.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1947*, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Police Arbitral Tribunal* Short title.
*Ordinance 1949.**

2.—(1.) Subject to sub-section (2.) of this section, the *Police Ordinance 1927-1947* shall, notwithstanding the making of any other Ordinance prior to the commencement of this Ordinance, continue to have the same force and effect as it had on the eighteenth day of May, One thousand nine hundred and forty-nine. Police Arbitral Tribunal.

(2.) The chairman of the Police Arbitral Tribunal established under the *Police Ordinance 1927-1947* shall be the Conciliation Commissioner who was the chairman of that Tribunal on the eighteenth day of May, One thousand nine hundred and forty-nine, or, in the event of that Commissioner's illness, absence from duty or ceasing to hold office as a Conciliation Commissioner, shall be such Conciliation Commissioner as is designated from time to time by the Governor-General.
