AN ORDINANCE

To amend the *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1930-1941*.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1947*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1950*.^{*} Short title
and citation.

(2.) The *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1930-1941* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1930-1950*.

2. The Third Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting therefrom the words and figures:— Third
Schedule.

"Police Ordinance 1927-1938		The whole
Police Superannuation Ordinance 1928-1938		The whole".

3. The Fifth Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting, after the words and figures "*Plant Diseases Ordinance 1934-1938*" and the words opposite thereto in the second column, the words and figures:— Fifth
Schedule.

"Police Ordinance 1927-1950		The whole
Police Superannuation Ordinance 1928-1950		The whole".
