AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1930-1941.

B^E it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938 and the Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1947, as follows:—

1.--(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Seat of Govern- Short title and citation. ment (Administration) Ordinance 1950.*

(2.) The Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1930-1941 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1930-1950.

2. The Third Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is amended Third Schedule.

3. The Fifth Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is amended by Fifth inserting, after the words and figures "*Plant Diseases Ordinance*" 1934-1938" and the words opposite thereto in the second column, the words and figures :—

"Police Ordinance 1927-1950 The whole Police Superannuation Ordinance 1928-1950 . . . The whole ".
