## AN ORDINANCE

To amend the *Advisory Council Ordinance*  
1936-1952.

### ADVISORY COUNCIL ORDINANCE 1957.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Advisory Council Ordinance* 1957.\* Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Advisory Council Ordinance* 1936-1952,† as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Advisory Council Ordinance* 1936-1957.

2. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of October, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-six. Commencement.

3. Section nine of the *Advisory Council Ordinance* 1936-1952 is repealed and the following section inserted in its stead:—

“9.—(1.) The Chairman of the Council, if an elected member of the Council, shall be paid an allowance at the rate of Two hundred pounds per annum. Allowances payable to elected members.

“(2.) Each elected member of the Council, not being the Chairman of the Council, shall be paid an allowance at the rate of One hundred pounds per annum.”
