ADVISORY COUNCIL ORDINANCE 1957.

- 1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Advisory Short title and Council Ordinance 1957.*
- (2.) The Advisory Council Ordinance 1936-1952,† as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Advisory Council Ordinance 1936-1957.
- 2. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into opera- Commencetion on the first day of October, One thousand nine hundred ment. and fifty-six.
- 3. Section nine of the Advisory Council Ordinance 1936-1952 is repealed and the following section inserted in its stead:—
- "9.—(1.) The Chairman of the Council, if an elected Allowances member of the Council, shall be paid an allowance at the rate payable to of Two hundred pounds per annum.
- "(2.) Each elected member of the Council, not being the Chairman of the Council, shall be paid an allowance at the rate of One hundred pounds per annum.".
