AN ORDINANCE

Relating to Pensions for Members of the Police Force of the Australian Capital Territory.

POLICE PENSIONS ORDINANCE 1958.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Police Pensions short title. Ordinance 1958.*

2. This Ordinance shall come into operation on the thirtieth commenceday of January, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-eight. ment.

3. The Ordinances specified in the First Schedule to this Repeat. Ordinance are repealed.

4.—(1.) A person whose name is specified in the first Pensionscolumn of the Second Schedule to this Ordinance shall be paid, payable to persons whether the paid persons whether the persons in lieu of the pension payable to that person under the *Police* Superannuation Ordinance 1928-1950, a pension at the rate specified in the second column of that Schedule opposite to the specified in the second column of that Schedule opposite to the name of that person.

(2.) Where a male person whose name is specified in the first column of the Second Schedule to this Ordinance dies and is survived by a widow (being his wife at the date of his retirement from the Police Force of the Australian Capital Territory), the widow shall be paid a pension at a rate equal to one half of the rate of the pension payable under this Ordinance to her husband.

(3.) The provisions of sections fourteen, fifteen and fifteen A of the *Police Superannuation Ordinance* 1928-1950, and the rules contained in paragraphs fourteen, sixteen, seventeen and eighteen of Part III. of the Schedule to that Ordinance, apply to and in relation to a pension payable under this Ordinance—

- (a) in the case of a pension payable to a male person in the same manner as they apply to superannuation allowance payable under that firstmentioned Ordinance; and
- (b) in the case of a pension payable to a female person —in the same manner as they apply to widow's allowance payable under that Ordinance.

(4.) In the application of the provisions and rules referred to in the last preceding sub-section to a pension payable under this Ordinance, a reference to "the Minister" or to "the Police Superannuation Board" shall be read as a reference to the Minister of State for the Interior.

Payments.

5. Payments of pension under this Ordinance shall be made out of moneys appropriated by the Parliament for the purpose.
