AN ORDINANCE

To amend the *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1930-1950*.

SEAT OF GOVERNMENT (ADMINISTRATION) ORDINANCE 1959.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1959*.^{*} Short title.

(2.) The *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1930-1950*[†] is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1930-1959*.

2. This Ordinance shall come into operation on the thirty-first day of December, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-nine. Commence-
ment.

3. Section four of the Principal Ordinance is repealed.

Repeal of
section 4.

4. Sections ten and eleven of the Principal Ordinance are repealed and the following section is inserted in their stead:—

“10.—(1.) Except as provided by this section, the Ordinances of the Territory shall be administered by the Minister of State for the Interior. Administration
of Ordinances.

“(2.) The Ordinances the titles of which are specified in Part 1 of the Second Schedule to this Ordinance shall be administered by the Attorney-General.

“(3.) The Ordinances the titles of which are specified in Part 2 of the Second Schedule to this Ordinance shall be administered by the Minister of State for Health.

“(4.) The Ordinances the titles of which are specified in Part 3 of the Second Schedule to this Ordinance shall be administered by the Treasurer.

“(5.) Where, in relation to an Ordinance specified in Part 1 of the Second Schedule to this Ordinance, a reference is made to specified provisions of that Ordinance, those provisions shall be administered by the Minister of State by whom the Ordinances in that Part are administered and the remaining provisions of that Ordinance shall be administered by the Minister of State for the Interior.

“(6.) An Ordinance made after the date of commencement of the *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance* 1959 shall, unless the contrary intention appears, be administered by the Minister of State for the Interior.”.

5. Sections thirteen and fourteen of the Principal Ordinance are repealed.

6. The Second Schedule, the Third Schedule, the Fourth Schedule, the Fifth Schedule and the Sixth Schedule to the Principal Ordinance are repealed and the following Schedule is inserted in their stead:—
