# LAND RENT (VALIDATION AND RE-APPRAISEMENT)

## No. 44 of 1970

An Ordinance relating to the Re-appraisement of Unimproved Values of certain Parcels of Land and to Land Rent by reference to that Re-appraisement.

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Land Rent (Validation and Short title. Re-appraisement) Ordinance 1970.\*
- 2.—(1.) In this Ordinance, a reference to the Principal Ordinance Interpretation. shall be read as a reference to the City Area Leases Ordinance 1936-1969.

(2.) In this Ordinance-

- "the Appeal Board" means the Appeal Board referred to in section 27 of the Principal Ordinance;
- "the re-appraised unimproved value", in relation to a parcel of land, means the unimproved value of the parcel of land that is to be deemed to have been re-appraised under the next succeeding section.
- (3.) Subject to the last preceding sub-section and unless the contrary intention appears, expressions used in this Ordinance that are defined by section 3 of the Principal Ordinance have the same respective meanings in this Ordinance.
- (4.) Where a date specified in the third column of the Schedule to this Ordinance opposite to an amount that is to be deemed to have been the re-appraised unimproved value of a parcel of land, being an amount specified in the second column of that Schedule, is a date before the fourteenth day of February, One thousand nine hundred and sixtysix, a reference to that amount expressed in decimal currency shall be read as a reference to the amount in the currency provided for by the Currency Act 1909-1947 that corresponds to that amount in decimal currency.
- (5.) References in the descriptions of parcels of land in the Schedule to this Ordinance to divisions, sections and blocks are references to divisions, sections and blocks of the Canberra City District within the meaning of the Districts Ordinance 1966-1967.
- 3.—(1.) For the purposes of the Principal Ordinance, the Leases Validation of (Special Purposes) Ordinance 1925-1943, and any provision in a lease ments. of a parcel of land described in the first column of the Schedule to this Ordinance relating to the payment of rent determined by reference to

the unimproved value of the parcel of land upon re-appraisement, but subject to the next succeeding section—

- (a) the unimproved value of the parcel of land by reference to which rent was payable under the lease in pursuance of whichever of those Ordinances is applicable shall be deemed to have been re-appraised as specified in the second column of that Schedule in relation to that description; and
- (b) the rent under the lease in pursuance of whichever of those Ordinances is applicable shall be deemed to have been payable at the rate of five per centum of the re-appraised unimproved value during the period from and including the date specified in the third column of that Schedule opposite to the amount of the re-appraised unimproved value specified in the second column of that Schedule until, subject to this section, the expiration of the period of twenty years after that date, the termination of the lease, or the thirty-first day of December, One thousand nine hundred and seventy, whichever first occurs.
- (2.) If the unimproved value of a parcel of land is to be deemed to have been re-appraised twice as specified in the second column to the Schedule to this Ordinance, the rent payable by reference to the first amount specified in that column as the re-appraised unimproved value of that parcel of land shall be deemed to have been payable until the day before the date specified in the third column of that Schedule opposite to the next such amount specified in the second column in relation to that parcel of land.

Application of section 3.

- 4.—(1.) The last preceding section has effect in relation to a lease of a parcel of land described in the first column of the Schedule to this Ordinance notwithstanding sections 25 and 26 of the City Area Leases Ordinance 1936 and sections 5A and 5B of the Leases (Special Purposes) Ordinance 1925-1943, or those Ordinances as amended and in force at the relevant time.
- (2.) For the purposes of the application of the provisions, covenants and conditions of a lease of a parcel of land described in the first column to the Schedule to this Ordinance relating to the payment of an amount by way of additional rent or an amount to be deemed to be rent, the last preceding section shall not be taken to have required the payment of rent at a rate determined under that section from the relevant date referred to in that section.

Liability.

- 5.—(1.) The person who is, at the date of commencement of this Ordinance, the lessee of a parcel of land the unimproved value of which is to be deemed to have been re-appraised under this Ordinance is liable to pay to the Commonwealth an amount equal to the difference (if any) between—
  - (a) the amount or amounts as and for rent in respect of the parcel of land determined by reference to the re-appraised unimproved value or values of the parcel of land under section 3 of this Ordinance; and

- (b) the total of the amount or amounts paid by the lessee since the date specified in the third column of the Schedule to this Ordinance in relation to that parcel of land, or, if there are two such dates so specified, since the first of those dates, or, if there were two or more lessees, by both or all those lessees, as and for rent under the lease.
- (2.) A reference to an amount paid as and for rent in paragraph (b) of the last preceding sub-section does not include a reference to an amount payable under a provision, covenant or condition of the lease by way of additional rent or an amount to be deemed by such a provision, covenant or condition to be rent.
- (3.) Notice of the amount payable under this section shall be given in writing to the lessee by the Minister within twenty-eight days after the commencement of this Ordinance.
- (4.) The amount payable under this section is payable within the period of three months after the date on which that notice is given to the lessee.
- 6.—(1.) A person who is, at the date of commencement of this Ordinance, the lessee under a lease of a parcel of land the rent in respect of which is to be deemed by this Ordinance to have been payable by reference to the re-appraised unimproved value of the parcel of land may appeal to the Appeal Board against that re-appraised unimproved value.

(2.) An appeal under this section shall be in writing, shall state the grounds of appeal and shall be lodged at the office of the Secretary to the Department of the Interior within the period of two months after the date of commencement of this Ordinance or such further period as the Minister, in special circumstances, allows.

- (3.) On receipt of an appeal, the Secretary to the Department of the Interior shall forthwith forward it to the Chairman of the Appeal Board who shall fix a time and place for the hearing and notify the appellant accordingly.
- (4.) The Appeal Board has the same powers in relation to an appeal under this section as it has in relation to an appeal under section 27 of the Principal Ordinance except that an appeal lies to the Supreme Court against a determination by the Appeal Board on the hearing of an appeal under this section.
- (5.) Where, in relation to a parcel of land referred to in sub-section (1.) of this section, an appeal against the purported re-appraisement of the unimproved value of that parcel of land (corresponding to the re-appraised unimproved value of that parcel of land under this Ordinance) has been heard by the Appeal Board before the date of commencement of this Ordinance under the City Area Leases Ordinance 1936-1969, or that Ordinance as amended, or under the Leases (Special Purposes) Ordinance 1925-1943, a further appeal to the Appeal Board against the re-appraised unimproved value does not lie under this section, but the person who is, at that date, the lessee under the lease of that parcel of land may appeal to the Supreme Court against the determination by the Appeal Board.
