### POLICE (DISCIPLINARY PROVISIONS) ORDINANCE 1973

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Police (Disciplinary Provisions) Ordinance 1973*.\*

Short title

(2) The *Police (Disciplinary Provisions) Ordinance 1972*,† as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Police (Disciplinary Provisions) Ordinance 1972-1973*.

2. Section 5 of the *Police (Disciplinary Provisions) Ordinance 1972* is amended by omitting sub-section (2) and substituting the following sub-section:—

Constitution  
of the Board.

“(2) The Chairman of the Board shall be a person who is a magistrate or a person whose name is on, and has appeared for at least five years on, a roll referred to in sub-section 55D (1) of the *Judiciary Act 1903-1969*.”.
