POLICE (DISCIPLINARY PROVISIONS) ORDINANCE 1973

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Police (Disciplinary Short title Provisions) Ordinance 1973.\* and citation.

(2) The Police (Disciplinary Provisions) Ordinance 1972,<sup>†</sup> as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Police (Disciplinary Provisions) Ordinance 1972-1973.

2. Section 5 of the Police (Disciplinary Provisions) Ordinance 1972 Constitution is amended by omitting sub-section (2) and substituting the following sub-section:----

"(2) The Chairman of the Board shall be a person who is a magistrate or a person whose name is on, and has appeared for at least five years on, a roll referred to in sub-section 55D (1) of the Judiciary Act 1903-1969.".
