POLICE (ADMINISTRATION) ORDINANCE (No. 2) 1975

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Police (Administration) Ordinance (No. 2) 1975*.* Short title.

2. (1) In this section, "Principal Ordinance" means the *Police Ordinance 1927-1974* as amended by the *Police (Administration) Ordinance 1975* and the *Police Ordinance 1975*. Amend-ments of the Police Ordinance.

(2) Section 3 of the Principal Ordinance is repealed.

(3) Section 6 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from sub-section (2) the words "Department of Police and Customs" and substituting the words "Department of the Capital Territory".

(4) Section 26A of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from sub-section (1) the words "Department of Police and Customs" and substituting the words "Department of the Capital Territory".

3. (1) In this section, "Principal Ordinance" means the *Police (Disciplinary Provisions) Ordinance 1972-1973* as amended by the *Police (Administration) Ordinance 1975*. Amend-ments of the Police (Disciplinary Provisions) Ordinance.

(2) Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is repealed.

(3) Section 47A of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from sub-section (1) the words "Department of Police and Customs" and substituting the words "Department of the Capital Territory".
