#### LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1977

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Legislative Assembly Short title (Amendment) Ordinance 1977.\*
- 2. After section 4 of the Legislative Assembly Ordinance 1936† Constitution the following sections are inserted:
  - of Legislative Assembly
- "4A. The term of office of a person who, on 9 October 1977, is, Extension or is to be deemed to be, a member of the Assembly, is, by force of this of term of section, extended and, notwithstanding sub-section 4 (3), the person certain shall continue to hold office as a member of the Assembly until-
  - (a) if a direction for an election of members of the Assembly is given under the Legislative Assembly (Election) Regulations and the date appointed for the polling at the election is a date earlier than 31 December 1978—the date appointed for the polling; or
  - (b) in any other case—31 December 1978.
- "4B. Where, on 9 October 1977, a member of the Assembly has Vacancy ceased to hold office and no person has been appointed to the vacant unfilled at 9 October office, section 6 applies as if the term of office of the member had been 1977 a term ending on the day on which the term of office of a person referred to in section 4A ends.".
