### To amend the Money Lenders Ordinance 1936

#### MONEY LENDERS (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1978

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Money Lenders (Amend-Short title ment) Ordinance 1978.\*
- 2. Section 4 of the *Money Lenders Ordinance* 1936† is amended Interpretation by adding at the end thereof the following sub-section:
  - "(2) In this Ordinance, unless the contrary intention appears—
    - (a) a reference, however expressed, to a body corporate includes a reference to—
      - (i) a foreign company as defined by section 5 of the Companies Ordinance 1962;
      - (ii) a society registered under the Co-operative Societies Ordinance 1939;
      - (iii) an association, society, institution or body incorporated under the Associations Incorporation Ordinance 1953; and
      - (iv) a bank as defined by section 5 of the *Banking Act* 1959; and
    - (b) a reference to an invitation to the public is a reference to an invitation, whether express or implied, oral or in writing, to any section of the public, however selected.".

3. After section 4 of the *Money Lenders Ordinance* 1936 the following section is inserted:

Exemption of certain loans

"4A. Notwithstanding sub-section 4 (1), a person is not, and shall not be taken ever to have been, a money lender for the purposes of this Ordinance by reason only that he has deposited money with, or lent money to, a corporation, or for the benefit of a proposed corporation, as a result of an invitation to the public issued, circulated or distributed by the corporation or another person."

Duplicates of contract or memorandum of particulars to be supplied by borrower in certain cases 4. Section 12 of the *Money Lenders Ordinance* 1936 is amended by omitting sub-section (4).
