An Ordinance to amend the *Fireworks Ordinance* 1972

### Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Fireworks (Amendment) Ordinance* 1982.<sup>1</sup>

### Interpretation

2. Section 2 of the *Fireworks Ordinance* 1972<sup>2</sup> is amended by omitting paragraph (a) of the definition of "day of celebration" and substituting the following paragraph:

"(a) the second Monday in June in each year, being the day specified in sub-paragraph 3 (1) (a) (via) of the *Holidays Ordinance* 1958 as the day for the observance of the anniversary of the birthday of the Sovereign; or".
