An Ordinance to amend the Fireworks Ordinance 1972

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Fireworks (Amendment) Ordinance 1982.

Interpretation

- 2. Section 2 of the *Fireworks Ordinance* 1972² is amended by omitting paragraph (a) of the definition of "day of celebration" and substituting the following paragraph:
 - "(a) the second Monday in June in each year, being the day specified in sub-paragraph 3 (1) (a) (via) of the *Holidays Ordinance* 1958 as the day for the observance of the anniversary of the birthday of the Sovereign; or".
