An Ordinance to amend the Health Commission Ordinance 1975

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Health Commission (Amendment) Ordinance (No. 2) 1984.* ¹

Principal Ordinance

2. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the *Health Commission Ordinance* 1975.²

Membership of Commission

3. Section 10 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by adding at the end of sub-section (2) "and shall hold office, subject to this Ordinance, on such terms and conditions as the Governor-General determines".

Leave of absence

4. Section 14 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting "The Minister" and substituting "Subject to sub-section 10 (2), the Minister".

Transitional

5. The Minister may, by instrument in writing, determine, subject to the Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance, the terms and conditions of employment of a person who holds office as a Commissioner at the date of commencement of this Ordinance.
